Information for persons sending correspondence via email

- 1) The controller of the personal data collected in the postal programme is PKP Polskie Linie Kolejowe Spółka Akcyjna, with its registered office at: 03-734, Warsaw, ul. Targowa 74, hereinafter referred to as the Company.
- 2) The fact of establishing electronic communication by user or by the Company entails that the email address, and other personal data provided, e.g. your name and surname, are entered into the Correspondence Register kept by the Company in the postal programme.
- 3) In the Company, there is an email address: iod.plk@plk-sa.pl of the Data Protection Inspector at PKP Polskie Linie Kolejowe S.A., which has been made available to the persons whose personal data are processed by the Company.
- 4) The legal basis for the processing of your personal data in the Correspondence Register, in connection with the email correspondence, are provisions of the Act on National Archive Resources and Archives.
- 5) Your personal data will not be made available to other recipients, unless specific provisions of law provide otherwise;
- 6) Your personal data will not be transferred to a non-European Economic Area country (third country), or to an international organisation within the meaning of the GDPR.
- 7) Your personal data will be stored in accordance with provisions of the aforementioned Act on National Archive Resources and Archives.
- 8) You have the right of access to your personal data, the right of rectification, erasure and blocking of the processing, the right to object to processing, and the right to data portability.
- 9) You have the right to file a complaint with a supervisory authority i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
- 10) The Company shall not make automated decisions, including profiling, on the basis of the personal data provided by the user.
